Bare your palate, Naked Earth Rouge has arrived, a blend made with certified organic grapes, grown in the Languedoc-Rousillon, the sun-soaked vineyards in the South of France. Stripped down to the basics of viticulture, Naked Earth's grapes are made by the environment in which it inhabits, meaning the vines live in ecological harmony with the soil, water and organisms of this precious land, and this in turn creates healthier grapes, grown in a natural setting.

In the winery is where the magic of nature transforms from pure terroir into your glass, where the same care that was given to nature continues into every bottle, each one a sample of the Naked Earth.

TASTING NOTES

Eye

A clean, pale gold, accented by the Chardonnay in the blend.

Nose

Floral and full on the nose, with scents of apricot and apple.

Palate

Crisp upon entry, with notes of lemon and grapefruit, leading into flavors of vanilla and hibiscus flowers; ends on a dry finish with gripping texture, generous minerality and balanced acidity.
