



HERITAGES ROUGE 2007

Ogier has remained a family winery since 1859. Today it is the oldest and largest wine cellar in the historic community of Châteauneuf-du-Pape, which was the summer residence of the Popes from 1309 to 1378. Now Ogier has been inspired to capitalize upon its special access to the best winegrowing estates by creating a new Côtes-du-Rhône cuvée called “Héritage”, a tribute both to the winery owners and to the 2000-year history of winemaking in the region. These three Héritage des Caves des Papes wines express the power and personality of the finest Côtes-du-Rhône varietals and also the unique and uncompromising winemaking tradition of Ogier.

TASTING NOTES

Eye

Deep, dark ruby color.

Nose

Complex bouquet of ripe fruit and earthiness.

Palate

Fine and silky tannin structure with notes of chocolate and coffee, fruity hints of strawberry and raspberry.
