Located in the right bank of the Rhône valley, La Côte Chéry consistently produces beautiful Viognier grapes, regardless of it being one of the harder grape varieties to grow. As Viognier has become more popular in today's market, La Cote Chéry Condrieu has kept up with the modern palate of today's wine drinker. This Viognier is exploding with bright notes of pear and apricot. The beauty of this vintage is in its concentration and full-bodiedness, making this a white wine for the red wine drinker.
